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ACCUMULATION OF CPD POINTS 2014

- Continuous professional Development of teachers and coaches is essential for the growth and development of aquatics
- Empowers teachers and coaches to keep abreast with the latest innovations in aquatics
- 8 CPD points must be accumulated annually by attending workshops and conferences & community events organised by the Provincial Education Training Committee.
- The affiliate will keep records of the number of points accumulated by their teachers and coaches
- During annual registrations teachers and coaches must show evidence of their accumulated CPD points
- Evidence can be provided in the form of certificates that were issued during the workshops (especially if the development was done in other Provinces)
- Teachers and coaches must support workshops and conferences coordinated by their Provincial affiliates unless the affiliate is not running any education and training programs.
- Points can be carried over if more than 8 points are accumulated in that year.
- If teachers and coaches attend any workshops outside SSA they need to verify with SSA if there will be CPD points issued.
- The following table is a breakdown of how the CPD points can be accumulated and if done accordingly it is possible for affiliates to have only one workshop per annum :

- One CPD point per contact hour of education applies to everyone.
- Workshops should be around R120 per session for registered members and double the price for those that are not registered
- Recommended number for workshops is about 30 people per session for a theory workshop and 20 for a practical workshop.
- Portability of training e.g. DVD individual 1 by 1 basis before sent to another province. (it is a possibility in the future)
- The above plan in terms of the allocation of points will enable teachers/coaches to attend at least one workshop and get other points from the other 2 areas. This would be affordable for teachers and coaches.
